### In the context of Jesus’ leaving. John 14:1-7

“Thomas said to him, ‘**Lord, we don’t know where you are going, so how can we know the way?**’” v. 5

“Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. **If you really knew me, you would know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him.**’” vv. 6-7
